

MEET OUR GUEST PASTOR ...

REV. NELSON METCALFE grew up in Summerside, Prince Edward Island, the eldest of five brothers.

Nelson received his elementary schooling in schools at Tufts Cove (now the north end of Dartmouth) and his high schooling at North Woodside High and Dartmouth High. His spiritual formation took place at Tufts Cove United Baptist Church (later Bethel Baptist).

In the fall of 1956, Nelson entered Acadia University graduating in 1961 with his Bachelor of Arts and in 1964 with his Bachelor of Divinity (later exchanged for a Master of Divinity degree). He was ordained to the Christian Ministry in his home church (Bethel Baptist) on May 18, 1964. In June of 1961 he married the former Arlene Schurman from Springhill.

He served as student pastor at Avonport-Lockhartville beginning in April of 1962. The pastorate decided to become full-time and called Nelson to stay which he did until the summer of 1969. It was during this time that two children were born to Nelson and Arlene:

Susan and Peter.

In 1969 Nelson and his family moved to Aylesford where Nelson became pastor of the Aylesford-Morristown-Lake Paul churches. In the summer of 1975 the family moved to Saint John where Nelson became the pastor of Lancaster Baptist Church where he ministered for twelve years. In 1987 he was called to become the Senior Pastor of the Bedford United Baptist Church where he served for seventeen years, retiring in the summer of 2004. He was made Pastor Emeritus in 2010.

In 2004, Nelson received the Acadia Divinity College Alumni Distinguished Service Award.

Having had six months of retirement, in February 2005 he began serving as part-time Minister of Visitation for First Baptist Church in Halifax from which he retired on December 31st, 2017.

Over the years, Nelson has been active in denominational ministries on both the Convention and Associational levels.

Besides preaching his passion has been music, having sung in every church choir where he has pastored. His musical hobby has been singing with the Barbershop Harmony Society for over 50 years.
